The Data Protection Act 2018 (DPA 2018), the UK's third generation of data protection law, came into effect on 25 May 2018, the same commencement day as that of the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

- What about the Privacy and Electronic Communications Regulations (PECR)?
