

5 Quick Predictions for Compliance in 2022

In this short film Cordery's Jonathan Armstrong gives 5 quick predictions for compliance in 2022. Jonathan's 5 themes are: 1.

1. GDPR & cookies - 2021 was the year when GDPR enforcement broke all records with more than €1bn in fines levied. 2022 has already seen activity too with France announcing cookies fines of €210m (see <https://bit.ly/cookiefr>). Jonathan predicts that, despite appeals against GDPR fines, 2022 will be another big year for enforcement with transparency being key.
2. Ransomware - again December 2021 looks to have been the busiest on record. Ransomware won't go away in 2022 and Jonathan predicts a rise in synthetic ransomware too. You can read some recent thoughts from Jonathan on the Blackbaud ransomware attack here <https://bit.ly/blackbaudr>.
3. Litigation after compliance events - Jonathan predicts no real let up in data breach litigation and predicts a rise in follow-on litigation after bribery investigations. You can find out more about data breach litigation in our recent film on YouTube here <https://bit.ly/classactionfilm>
4. Whistleblowing - Jonathan talks of the increase in whistleblowing following on from the EU Whistleblowing Directive. There are some FAQs on the Directive here <https://bit.ly/euwhistle>
5. Supply chain compliance - this will include managing risk in your supply chain. Due diligence will be key. ESG & modern slavery will be a special concern.
