Although the UK is likely to develop privacy laws similar to the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) they are not yet on the books. That could have implications for processing data.

In addition there will need to be an Adequacy decision for the UK and probably a Privacy Shield in place between the UK the US.

Data processors will also need to ensure that they understand what can and can't be done with legacy data.
